FLORENCE V.0007S/0008N
CHANGE TO PORT ROTATION ON AUSTRALIAN COAST

Pacific Forum Line received confirmation today that, due to congestion, Florence V0007S/008N will not get a berth in Sydney until 22/09/2010. In order to avoid unnecessary delays the decision has been made to change the port rotation on the Australian coast. Therefore, upon departure from Melbourne, the vessel will sail directly to Brisbane, thence back to Sydney, before heading off to the regular Island ports.
