



PFL ANNOUNCES INCREASED FREQUENCY

FROM NZ TO FIJI SAMOA & TONGA

We recognise there is a need to immediately address the concerns clients have expressed with regards the current level of frequency offered on our service to the above ports.

This week the m.v. “Salzburg” was chartered to operate in tandem with “Southern Lily”, she arrived in Auckland today. “Salzburg will now commence loading for Tonga and Samoa to clear the current overflow. This vessel will also be retained to meet the peak season demand.

As we know, after Christmas volumes drop dramatically, however it is our intention to maintain a two ship service to Fiji, Samoa and Tonga. As a consequence, a vessel has been identified and chartered, which on completion of her docking will join “Southern Lily” to coincide with the New Year lift in cargo.
